Founded in 2002 by President William J. Clinton and Ira Magaziner, the Clinton Health Access Initiative, Inc. ("CHAI") is a global health organization committed to strengthening integrated health systems and expanding access to care and treatment in the developing world. CHAI's Zimbabwe program, funded through the Beginnings Fund (BF), works in close partnership with the Ministry of Health and Child Care (MoHCC) to introduce and scale up critical maternal and newborn health commodities and technologies across the country.

CHAI Zimbabwe, in partnership with MoHCC, is undertaking a catalytic introduction of Heat-Stable Carbetocin (HSC) — a WHO-recommended, thermostable uterotonic for the prevention of postpartum haemorrhage (PPH) — at 8 high-volume delivery facilities. CHAI invites qualified prospective and interested suppliers to submit quotations to supply and deliver the item specified below.

Quantity	3,000 ampoules
Manufacturer / Product Quality	WHO Prequalification (PQ) or Stringent Regulatory Authority (SRA) approval required for the product (manufacturer name not restricted)
Regulatory Status	Product should be registered, and hold active registration status with the Medicines Control Authority of Zimbabwe (MCAZ)
Shelf Life	Shelf life must be active on delivery, with expiry date running to at least December 2027.
Storage / Cold Chain	standard ambient storage ($\leq 30^{\circ}\text{C}$) acceptable — no cold chain required
Packaging	Indicate pack/carton sizes available (e.g., 5 or 10 ampoules per box)

- Payment terms: Net 14 days from receipt of items and completion of delivery
- Currency: United States Dollars (USD)
- Product shelf life should be clearly indicated in the quotation

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Company profile detailing capacity and experience supplying pharmaceutical products
- Product information, including WHO Prequalification or SRA approval documentation
- Certificate of Analysis (CoA) for the product, if available
- GMP and quality certification documentation (e.g., manufacturing license and quality certification held by the manufacturer)
- Evidence of active MCAZ registration status
- Compliance with Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) and WHO pharmaceutical quality assurance guidelines
- Company Tax clearance certificate
- CR14 (if registered in Zimbabwe)

- Quotations should be submitted in English, in USD.
- Quotations must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. CAT on 4 September 2026.

- Quotations should be valid for 30 days to allow time for evaluation.
